Hearing and Responding to Words and Syllables in Songs and Poems

Favorite children's programs and videos often have songs your child likes to sing. Invite your child to choose songs and poems from audio and video resources you choose.

- Clap to each syllable in the words. (Mar-y had a lit-tle lamb. Lit-tle lamb. Lit-tle lamb ...)
